

Decommissioning of MIKE URBAN

DHI is releasing MIKE URBAN+ in May 2019. MIKE URBAN+ is the next generation of MIKE URBAN.

MIKE URBAN+ will be released in 2 parts, the first release in May 2019 includes MIKE URBAN+ for water distribution and collection systems. The second release includes the 2D overland flow.

The release of MIKE URBAN+ means that DHI will initiate decommission of MIKE URBAN (and MOUSE engine).

Release of MIKE2020 (planned for Q4 2019) will include the last release of MIKE URBAN. After that MIKE URBAN will be decommissioned, following the principles and legal requirements for this.

All existing MIKE URBAN users with a valid SMA agreement on the date of the release of MIKE URBAN+ will get access to MIKE URBAN+ at no additional cost as part of the SMA.

From 2020-01-01 updates and other releases related to MIKE URBAN+ will follow the general principles of DHI's SLA agreement at that time.

The decommission plan is as follows:

- 1st notification on decommission (this note) is sent out through the landing page on the same date as the 1st release of MIKE URBAN+
- All new sales of MIKE URBAN+ in 2019 will include MIKE URBAN at no additional cost.
- Release MIKE2020 (Q4 2019) will include the last release of MIKE URBAN.
- No sale of MIKE URBAN after release of MIKE 2020.
- After MIKE 2020 release, maintenance mode is entered for MIKE URBAN and it will be supported for the required following 12 months
- In Q4 2020 MIKE URBAN will be finally decommissioned and reach end of life.
